THE ETHAN ALLEN LONG RIFLES, INC.

The EALR is a muzzle loading, shooting, and living history club incorporated in the State of Vermont with members from South Carolina to Quebec. Primitive shoots are held on an irregular basis at the range in Bristol and Underhill, VT. Most of the Members also reenact. We have several different reenactment identities (Committees) to choose from. Some like to try their hand at several. The names of the currently recognized units follow.

Les Troupes de la Pointe a la Chevelure – This is a French and Indian War portrayal consisting of French Marines and Canadian Militia (Milice). This mix allows those who like a uniform to wear one as well as making room for those who prefer a more civilian portrayal. Each of the two portrayals operates as a joint unit at reenactments. It is also a charter member of the *Early North American Living History Association*.

Colonel Seth Warner's Extra-Continental Regiment – This American Revolution unit was an Additional Continental Regiment, initially raised from the old Green Mountain Boys, and was the only Continental Regiment raised principally in Vermont. Primarily a 'uniformed' Regiment of Continental Infantry, the unit also has a Militia 'augmentation' portrayal for those members who don't care to take the Continental Bounty. The Regiment currently consists of the *Regimental Field & Staff*, *Captain Hopkins' (1st) Company*, *Captain Brownson's (2nd) Company*, and *the Distaff*, all operating under a unified command. *Warner's Regiment* is also a member unit of the *Continental Line Inc.* and a founding member of the *Vermont Brigade*.

Compagnie de Langis – This is a French and Indian War portrayal of a unit of French "Rangers". Commanded by Ensign (de la Marine) de Langis, this unit had the same kind of reputation in the Northern English Colonies that Rogers' Rangers had among the French. The recreated unit is focused on a more "progressive" approach to re-enacting, forgoing the more common comforts one associates with a re-enacted camp and a more physically demanding on field presence than is usually seen in the French forces. *Compagnie de Langis* is also a charter member of the *Early North American Living History Association*.

Highlanders of History – This is a portrayal of Scottish Highlander life focusing on His Majesty's 78th Regiment of Foot (Frasier's Highlanders) and the Government Company of Highlanders of the Jacobite Revolution. The recreated units present the life and lifestyle of the Highlanders in camp and campaign during the French and Indian War, 1755-1763 and the Jacobite Revolt of 1746. *HM 78th Regt (Frazier's Highlanders)* is also a charter member of the *Early North American Living History Association*.
