The EALR is a muzzle loading, shooting, and living history club incorporated in the State of Vermont with members from South Carolina to Quebec. Primitive shoots are held on an irregular basis at the range in Bristol and Underhill, VT. Most of the Members also reenact. We have several different reenactment identities (committees) to choose from. Some like to try their hand at several.

The names of the currently recognized units follow:

Les Troupes de la Pointe à la Chevelure – is a Seven years War (French and Indian War) portrayal of French Milice who are a militia unit drawn from local "habitants" and those who support them. The original unit was based out of Pointe a la Chevelure (Chimney Point, VT and Crown Point, NY). The recreated unit portrays the militia from Fort St. Frederick area that were called up to defend Nouvelle France and those who might be found in the Milice encampment in the 1750s–1760s. Colonel Seth Warner's Extra-Continental Regiment – This American Revolution unit was an Additional Continental Regiment, initially raised from the old Green Mountain Boys, and was the only Continental Regiment raised principally in Vermont. Primarily a 'uniformed' Regiment of Continental Infantry, the unit also has a Militia 'augmentation' portrayal for those members who don't care to take the Continental Bounty. The Regiment currently consists of the *Regimental Field & Staff*, *Captain Hopkins' (1st) Company*, *Captain Brownson's (2nd) Company*, and *the Distaff*, all operating under a unified command. *Warner's Regiment* is also a member unit of the *Continental Line Inc.* and a founding member of the *Vermont Brigade*.

La Compagnie de Langis – (Langis' Company) is a New England-based living history group portraying one of the ad-hoc companies led by Ensign Jean-Baptiste Levrault de Langis Montegron during the French and Indian War (1754-1763). We also portray French Canadian and Native women and families as well as civilians who may depict trades, crafts, or other 18th century techniques. All of us strive to be as historically correct as we reasonably can, we are always trying to improve, and we enjoy talking with and educating the public about history as we continue to gather new skills and discover more about our time period. On the battlefield, we tend to move quickly and fire in pairs, and at our campsite, our set-up is minimal because we demonstrate the way our company would be while on campaign. Bauman's Company, 2nd Continental Artillery -- This is a portrayal of a company of artillery of Major Sebastian Bauman. Bauman's Company was authorized on October 28th 1775 to be one of three companies recruited in New York which became part of Lamb's Artillery. It was assigned to Washington's Main Army on the 13th of April 1776. Lamb's Regiment was designated a Continental Regiment on the 1st of January 1777, and Bauman was promoted to Colonel. It was reassigned as one of 4 Continental Regiments created by Congress in 1777. The 2nd Continental Artillery added 3 more New York companies, 4 Connecticut companies, and 2 companies from Pennsylvania, for a total of 12 companies. On June 12th 1777, Lamb's Artillery was assigned to the Highland Department. For more information please review our Facebook site: 2nd Continental Artillery, Bauman's Company.
